Base Rental Fee: \$250

### Notes:

- Rental is for a 4-hour time period
  - o Additional time is available for a fee of \$40 / hour, and shall be discussed at the time of booking
- Base Rental Fee includes:
  - Access to the ice, clubhouse, and washrooms
  - Complimentary use of club brooms and sliders
  - Provision of a certified Bartender for beverage services and general oversight / supervision of the rental
    - Note: the Nosbonsing Curling Club bar stocks many alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages as well as light snacks which may be purchased on-site with cash or debit
  - Pre- and post-cleaning services by the Nosbonsing Curling Club
- Outside food and non-alcoholic beverages may be brought in for rentals; however, no alcoholic beverages may be brought inside the Curling Club
- Rental fees are due on the day of rental and may be paid via cash, debit, cheque (payable to Nosbonsing Curling Club) or EMT (to <u>nosbonsingcurling@gmail.com</u>)
- All participants must enter the ice area with clean running shoes (no outdoor shoes) or curling shoes, and lint-free clothing
- Helmets are strongly recommended for anyone curling under the age of 16, and mandatory for anyone under the age of 12

Scenario No. 1: Club Member Has Smart Serve Certification / Will Manage Bar

Base Rental Fee: \$100

Scenario No. 2: Club Member Does Not Have Smart Serve Certification / Bar Service Is Not Desired

Base Rental Fee: \$100

Scenario No. 3: Club Member Does Not Have Smart Serve Certification / Bar Service Is Desired

Base Rental Fee: \$200

### Notes:

Rental is for a 4-hour time period

- Under Scenario's 1 & 2, additional time is available for a fee of \$20 / hour, and shall be discussed at the time of booking
- Under Scenario 3, additional time is available for a fee of \$40 / hour, and shall be discussed at the time of booking
- Under Scenario No. 1
  - Club Member shall be responsible for stocking the bar fridges after the event
  - Only the Club Member responsible for the rental shall access and service the bar area (even if other attendees have certification)
- Under Scenario's 1&2
  - Club Member shall be responsible for pre- and post-cleaning activities (i.e., table and bar surfaces wiped; vacuuming the lounge; cleaning the washrooms; other miscellaneous cleaning as required)
- Under Scenario 3
  - The Nosbonsing Curling Club Bartender will be responsible for all bar and cleaning requirements
- All Base Rental Fees include:
  - Access to the ice, clubhouse, and washrooms
